NEW NAMIBIA STANDARDS COUNCIL APPOINTED

The newly appointed Namibia Standards Council was inaugurated by Hon. Lucia Lipumbu on Wednesday, 31 August 2022. The appointment of the Council is done in accordance with section 6 (3) and (4) of the Standards Act, 2005 (No. 18 of 2005), read with the Public Enterprises Governance Act, 2019 (No. 1 of 2019) and Cabinet Decision No.10th/28.06.22/012.

The NSC is responsible for the management, conducting, supervision, and control of the affairs and activities, and the performance of the functions, of the Namibia Standards Institute, including the maintenance and safekeeping of proper records of accounts and financial statements of the Institute.

The new council members are Mr. Paulus Natangwe Kalenga and Ms. Matilda Kahimbi Jankie-Shakwa who will serve as chairperson and vice chairperson respectively; and Mr. Vincent Nowaseb, Mr. Thaddeus Eli-Megameno Shigwedha, Mr. Lloyd Liewelly Londt and Ms. Monica Nehemia as members.

The appointment is effective for a period of 3 years from 1 July 2022 - 30 June 2025.

The Council replaces Prof. Martha Kandawa-Schulz; Ms. Rosalinda Katjivena, Mr. Milton Louw, Dr. Penny Hiwilepo-van Hal, Mr. Axel Tibinyane, Mr. John Ali Ipinge, and Ms. Ainna Vilengi Kaundu as outgoing members.
